Final section of Eldorado concrete work begins today

LITTLE ELM (August 28, 2015) Work on the final stretch of Eldorado Parkway begins today as crews from the contractor will open the newly-poured inside lanes between Witt Road and Little Elm Parkway, according to Alan Anderson, the Town's Engineering Manager.

"Both the eastbound and westbound inside lanes will be opened along that stretch, and traffic will be directed to use them exclusively," he said.

The section is between Little Elm Parkway on the east end, and on the west end, the intersection of Eldorado Parkway with Witt Road on the south and Woodlake Drive on the north.

The traffic shift is necessary to complete the work on the outside lanes on both sides of Eldorado Parkway.

"This final section will take most of September," said Anderson. "By then, we should be effectively complete with the roadbed construction. At the same time, the remaining work on the medians, laying sod on the sections along the curbs, and the lighting should also be close to completion."

The entire project is under the auspices of the Texas Department of Transportation, which is responsible for the construction, in collaboration with its contractors.
