Annual Senior Craft Fair in Little Elm set for Nov. 5

Free event offers one-of-a-kind gift ideas

LITTLE ELM (October 12, 2016) Vendors who participate in the Little Elm Senior Citizen Craft Fair are gearing up for its one-day run by putting the finishing touches on their creations.

“The creativity of our vendors often leaves me speechless,” says Brenda Button Mills Senior Center Supervisor Annette Carrico. “And, those who know me will understand the significance of that statement. Every year, we are pleasantly surprised with the quality and character of our vendor offerings.”

The sixth annual Little Elm Senior Citizen Craft Fair is set for Saturday, Nov. 5 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. The center will once again be the site of the fair, 301 Main St. in Little Elm. The center is located adjacent to the Little Elm Recreation Center.

As has been the case every year, vendors will be displaying and offering for sale unique, handmade articles. These include wooden toys and figurines, quilts and quilted items, knitted objects, holiday-themed gifts and one-of-a-kind jewelry.

Entry into the craft fair is free, and food and drinks will be available for purchase.

“People looking for something to use as gifts for the holiday will surely find something that no one else has,” said Carrico. “The variety of merchandise is really hard to describe. In fact, we’re anxious to see what these handcrafters come up with this year.”

The Brenda Button Mills Senior Center is operated by the Town of Little Elm, and is open year-round, providing a place for area senior citizens to gather for socialization, education and entertainment.

ABOUT LITTLE ELM – Little Elm is one of the state’s fastest growing communities. Nestled on the shores of Lake Lewisville, the Town was incorporated in 1966, adopting the Council/Manager form of government. The population increased dramatically over the last several years, growing from under 4,000 in 2000 to over 30,000 today. Little Elm’s population exceeds the state average in education and income, and is increasingly trending younger and technologically proficient. The Town’s footprint is just over 21 square miles and boasts some 66 linear miles of shoreline within its boundaries.
